These release notes provide information about the One Identity Starling Two-Factor AD FS Adapter release.

About this release

Starling Two-Factor AD FS Adapter integrates with Microsoft Active Directory Federation Services (AD FS) 3.0 to add two-factor authentication to services using browser-based federated logins. Starling Two-Factor AD FS Adapter supports relying parties that use Microsoft WS-Federation protocol, like Office 365, as well as SAML 2.0 federated logons for cloud apps like Google Apps and salesforce.com. Starling Two-Factor AD FS Adapter with AD FS 3.0 supports Windows Server 2012 R2.

Known issues

The following is a list of issues known to exist at the time of release.

Table 1: General known issues

Known Issue	Issue ID
When logging in to AD FS, you get an error message if you have entered an incorrect subscription key in Starling Two-Factor AD FS Adapter settings. WORKAROUND Open Starling Two-Factor AD FS Adapter Configuration tool and enter the correct subscription key.	4519
When logging in to AD FS, if you enter incorrect one-time password several times in a short time interval, you get an error message. WORKAROUND Wait for some time and try again.	5181
Push notifications requests are not displayed in the phone notification list, though they are sent. WORKAROUND Open Starling 2FA app and go to OneTouch menu. Verify whether the requests are displayed in the Pending tab.	17422
