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Installing This Update

1. Install the "PAConsole_Pro.msi" on the computer where the console is installed or desired to be installed. This MSI will automatically upgrade over top of previous installations of the console for versions v4.1.2.x and below.
2. If the "Deploy Client" feature is configured to deploy the client to target machines, then this process will automatically trigger the new PAClient.msi to be pushed out to the configured computers.
3. If the "Deploy Client" feature was not used to deploy the client to target machines, then use desired MSI deployment mechanism to push the "PAClient.msi" included in this hotfix out to target computers
