Required Installation Instructions

!!IMPORTANT! YOU MUST APPLY OSPATCH_3106991 AND THEN REBOOT PRIOR TO UPGRADE. FOR INFORMATION ON THIS PATCH, PLEASE REFER TO [KB 250954](#).

!!IMPORTANT! THE 2.5.920 PATCH COULD TAKE UP TO AN HOUR TO APPLY, PLEASE BE PATIENT TO GIVE IT TIME TO INSTALL AND REPLICATE TO THE REPLICAS BEFORE REBOOTING.

!!IMPORTANT! WE RECOMMEND PUTTING THE APPLIANCE IN MAINTENANCE MODE AND REBOOTING BEFORE AND AFTER THE PATCH HAS APPLIED.

!!IMPORTANT! WE RECOMMEND REBOOTING ANY REPLICA AFTER CONFIRMING IT IS UPGRADED.

This patch will update a TPAM 2.5.913 through 2.5.919 appliance to the latest released version of 2.5.920. The minimum version in order to apply the patch is 2.5.913.

Warning: Since this patch can take several minutes to apply, the failover interval needs to be increased for any failover replicas to prevent them from failing over and not getting upgraded.

Option: /genkey

NOTE: If using TPAM API's a new version of the API must be downloaded and the applications using them updated. When using the APIs or CLI, it is possible the syntax of the commands, parameters and output changes between TPAM versions. Refer to the TPAM 2.5 Administration Guide under chapters "CLI Commands" and "Application Programming Interface (API)" for more information
