Quest Secure Copy is a comprehensive solution for data duplication, local group and user migration, share migration, and NTFS permissions configuration. Secure Copy permits seamless migration, allowing an administrator to copy files and directories on NTFS partitions while keeping the security intact, creating shares, and migrating local groups. All of this functionality is available in an easy to use interface, which keeps you updated on copy progress, as well as any errors that may occur.

PowerShell integration

If you already had Windows PowerShell installed on your computer before you installed Secure Copy®, the Secure Copy cmdlets were automatically installed and registered with Windows PowerShell.

The Secure Copy cmdlets allow you to perform some of the functions of Secure Copy in an automation environment. The cmdlets also can be of great use in any environment where a repetitive process involving Secure Copy is needed.

Miscellaneous enhancements

- Added an option to delete orphaned files or folders on a local computer to Recycle Bin.
- Supported using SSL/TLS connection to send report e-mail.
- Added filters to filter orphaned files or folders by specific date.
- Added the ability to log the details of migrating permissions.

- Added an option to force inheritance for all target folders.
- Improved the performance of handling very large log files.
- The **Synchronize Last Access Date and Created Date on target files with source** and **Synchronize Last Access Date and Modified Date on target folder with source** are now checked by default. If you uncheck any of these two options, it displays a warning for you to confirm.
- Removed the limit of the max files number to be tested if the Secure Copy has a valid license.
- Added the ability to import multiple paths to File System Statistics by using a csv file.
- Upgraded SQLite to the latest version.
- Improved the user experience of using the SMBv2 protocol or higher versions.
