

One Identity Active Roles Add-on for Recovery Manager for Active Directory 1.5.0

These release notes provide information about the One Identity Active Roles Add-on for Recovery Manager for Active Directory release.

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About One Identity Active Roles Add-on for Recovery Manager for Active Directory 1.5.0

With **One Identity Active Roles Add-on for Recovery Manager for Active Directory**, you can use the **Active Roles** Web Interface to perform the following tasks:

- Restore directory object properties from a backup: For a given user, computer, group or contact object, restore the object to the state that it was in at the time the backup was created by Recovery Manager for Active Directory. This allows you to undo the changes to the object that were made since the time of backup creation.

- Restore deleted directory objects from a backup: For a given Organizational Unit (OU) or container, view and restore (undelete) objects that were deleted from that OU or container since the time the backup was created by Recovery Manager for Active Directory. You can restore (undelete) objects that exist in the backup to the OU or container from which those objects were deleted.

The add-on leverages a Web portal provided by Recovery Manager to restore objects and object properties in Active Directory. To perform a restore, the add-on user requires sufficient rights in Recovery Manager to search the Deleted Objects container, retrieve data from backups, and restore data to Active Directory. For instructions on how to perform a restore using the **Recovery Manager Portal**, refer to Recovery Manager documentation.

- Support for Active Roles 7.4.

Getting started with Active Roles Add-on for RMAD 1.5.0

Contents of the Release Package

The release package contains the following items:

- Add-on installation file (*.arsaddon)
- Release Notes (this document)

Installation Instructions

The add-on installation file has the **.arsaddon** file name extension. Use **ActiveRoles Add-on Manager** to open that file and install the add-on.

1. In the Active Roles console tree, select **Applications | Add-on Manager**.
2. In the details pane, click **Install add-on from file** and open the add-on installation file (*.arsaddon).

Instead of opening the add-on installation file from the Active Roles console, you may double-click that file in Windows Explorer to start the installation process.

3. Follow the steps in the **Add-on Installation** wizard.
4. On the Web Interface **Customization** page, select the Web Interface sites to which you want the add-on to add the **Recovery Manager for Active Directory** user management commands and pages.

The Web Interface **Customization** page first prompts you to select the configuration of the Web Interface site and then selects the Web Interface sites that use the configuration you selected. To determine which configuration is used by a given Web Interface site, you can use the Web Interface Sites Configuration tool on the computer running the Web Interface.

5. Wait while **Add-on Manager** installs the add-on and customizes the Web Interface. When finished, close the **Add-on Installation** wizard.

After you have installed the add-on, configure it by using the Active Roles console.

1. In the console tree, select **Applications | Active Roles Add-on for RMAD**.
2. In the details pane, type the URL path of the **Recovery Manager Portal** in the URL path of the portal field, and then click **Apply**.

The format of the URL path is `<servername>/<appname>` where `<servername>` stands for the fully qualified domain name of the Web server running the portal and `<appname>` stands for the Web application name specified when installing the portal

(**RecoveryManagerPortal** by default). Example:
server.domain.corp/RecoveryManagerPortal

3. In the Active Roles Web Interface, run the **Customization | Reload** command for the add-on configuration to take effect.

Using the Add-on

After you have installed and configured the add-on, you can use the **Active Roles** Web Interface to perform the following tasks:

- Restore directory object properties from a backup
- Restore deleted directory objects from a backup

To restore directory object properties from a backup:

1. In the **Active Roles** Web Interface, select a user, computer, group or contact object, and then choose the **Restore Object** command to open the **Recovery Manager Portal**.
2. Follow the instructions in the **Recovery Manager Portal** to restore the object you've selected.

To restore deleted directory objects from a backup:

1. In the **Active Roles** Web Interface, select an **Organizational Unit (OU)** or container, and then choose the **Undelete Child Objects** command to open the **Recovery Manager Portal**.
2. In the **Recovery Manager Portal**, perform a search for objects that were deleted from the OU or container you've selected, and then follow the instructions in the portal to restore the objects that you want to restore.
