Installation

System requirements

Before installing SQL Optimizer for IBM® DB2® z/OS®, ensure your system meets the following minimum hardware and software requirements:

Platform	600 MHz minimum, 1 GHz recommended
Memory	512 MB of RAM minimum, 1 GB of RAM recommended Note: The memory required may vary based on the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applications that are running on your system.• Size and complexity of the database.• Amount of database activity.• Number of concurrent users accessing the database

Install or Upgrade SQL Optimizer

To install or upgrade SQL Optimizer

1. Run the SQL Optimizer installation program.
2. Complete the wizard.

Install SQL Optimizer Silently

This topic focuses on information that may be unfamiliar to you. It does not include all step and field descriptions.

To perform a silent installation of SQL Optimizer

Execute the following command:

```
msiexec /i "path to msi file\QuestSQLOptimizerForIBMDB2zOS_x_x_x_x.msi" /qn
```

Note: The following command line options are used:

Command-Line Option	Definition
/i	installs the product
/qn	Sets user interface to No UI

To perform a silent installation of SQL Optimizer in a directory different from the default product directory

Execute the following command:

```
msiexec /i "path to msi file\QuestSQLOptimizerForIBMDB2zOS_x_x_x_x.msi" /qn  
INSTALLDIR="InstallDir"
```

Uninstall SQL Optimizer

To uninstall SQL Optimizer

1. Go to **Control Panel | Programs | Uninstall a program**
2. Select SQL Optimizer for IBM DB2 z/OS, and complete the wizard.

Register SQL Optimizer

To register the trial or production version

1. Select **Help | Licensing**.
2. Enter your Authorization key.
3. Enter your site message if you have a Production key.
4. Click **Apply**.
