## Previous Updates

- A new notes.ini parameter, BTBlockNotesEncrypted, has been implemented. When enabled, any encrypted message from Domino to Exchange is blocked with a configurable NDR returned. (75342)
- Support for BTConvertPNG and all associated 3rd party libraries has been removed. If BTConvertPNG is enabled in the notes.ini file, the message "BTConvertPNG has been deprecated and is no longer supported in BTCal." will be logged. (75433)

### 20.05

- An issue causing an NDR to be generated for meeting invitations from Teams with a URL that contains the text "=3d" has been resolved. The setting BTPRIVATEHANDLEQP has been added so that, when enabled, BTCal will not block quoted-printable iCal streams but will instead process them. (75187)
- When adding a Domino room to a meeting invite using Outlook Web App (OWA), the document gets delivered to Domino Resource Reservations database as a Notice and not a Reservation. This issue has been resolved. (75192)

- An issue preventing the setting of the NDRUID value for NDR41 if the ApptUNID buffer in the CheckCalendar() function is empty has been fixed. (70672)

- An enhancement to handle large iCal meeting requests with the body or list of attendees exceeding 25 KBs has been implemented. (67468)
- An issue causing BTCal to crash when a meeting does not contain a Location has been resolved. (66256)
- A bug preventing NDR22 text from processing correctly has been fixed. (62816)
- An issue causing the Outlook chair to receive an NDR when adding a second Notes invitee to more than one instance of a recurring meeting has been fixed. (63123)
- An enhancement was implemented to support the adding of spaces between each domain name listed in the Notes.INI parameter 'BTPROCESSDOMAIN'. (63328)

Three types of licenses for BTCal are offered: a fully functional, but expiring, trial license; a full standard license; and a standard license with ZApp support.

When a trial license expires, the product shuts down and stops working. A standard license (with or without ZApp), however, includes software assurance which allows you to upgrade to any versions of BTCal that become available while the license is valid. When the license expires, BTCal will continue working, but you will need to purchase a new license to upgrade to any new versions.
