# What's New

## Version 20.11 Release Notes

There are no new release notes for Binary Tree Directory Sync Pro for Notes version 20.11.

## Previous Releases

### 19.07.04

- An issue causing users to be re-added to Groups after previously being deleted during successive syncs to Active Directory has been resolved. (75209)

### 19.07.02

- An enhancement to always set the Domino GroupType value to '0' for multipurpose (instead of '1' for mail-only) when syncing from Domino to Active Directory has been implemented. (72437)
- An issue causing errors to be reported during the synchronization of group memberships from Domino to Active Directory when a group contains an SMTP external address that is longer than 100 characters has been resolved. The issue was fixed by replacing the SMTP address with its hash for some fields in Active Directory which are limited to 64 characters. (62330)

### 19.07

- An enhancement to reduce the number of 'Out of Memory' exceptions when processing large numbers of groups from Domino to AD has been implemented. (65654)
- The default value of the 'Clear Log Automatically' setting has been configured to 3 weeks. This is an enhancement to prevent excessive log growth when the option is not configured during implementation. (65655)
- An enhancement to ensure proper database replication by adding a primary key to four SQL tables has been implemented. (67430)
- An enhancement to restart a sync from the point at which it was cancelled has been implemented. (67672)
- An enhancement to always save the last sync time regardless of where there were errors has been implemented. This is controlled by setting the value of 'AlwaysStampLastSyncTime' in the .config file to "true". (68275)
- Some corrections and enhancements were made to the Directory Sync Pro for Domino install wizard text. (68800)
- An issue causing the DirSync\_DefaultSettings default values to be set incorrectly has been fixed. (68822)
- An enhancement to allow the syncing of group memberships for Domino members to continue when these exist in two different untrusted AD domains and to skip membership of the secondary untrusted AD forest has been implemented. (68269)
- An issue preventing the userPrincipalName from populating during the initial sync has been fixed. (69190)

- An issue preventing `targetAddress` from being assigned a NULL value from Domino has been fixed. (69902)

## 19.03

- The Update Objects field was added to the DirSync console to sync *updates* made to mail enabled and mailbox enabled objects. (60878)
- Functionality was added to sync *deleted* mailbox enabled objects when the “Mailbox Enabled” or “Both” options are selected on the DirSync console’s new Update Objects field. (60879)
- An issue causing items to be deleted after migrating from Domino to Active Directory when the parameter Available For Foreign Sync is set to ‘0’ (“No”) has been fixed. A new setting ‘Skip Target Deletion For Source Objects Marked As Not Available For Sync’ has been added to the application to prevent (if checked) target objects from being deleted unless the source object is manually deleted. (61679)
- An issue with receiving log errors when syncing large groups has been resolved. (61706)
- Performance for large synchronization throughput has been improved. (63636)
- The DirSync console now reflects real time status updates in the in the Object Status and Members Status columns. Each column now shows the number of *read* objects followed by the number of *processed* objects. (63582)
- An issue where the `DisableSyncReportInitialization` key would not work has been resolved. (63590)
- Some or all types of the source Domino objects can now be synced from multiple Domino servers. (63609)
- An enhancement was made to the SQL Mail Domain column to enable data population. (65678)
